### HOT WEATHER ADVICE

We have had a few people feeling unwell or faint at church recently in the hot weather. Church is a very common place to feel faint because there is lots of standing up and it is more common to faint if you are older or have other health conditions.

As a GP, I just wanted to share some advice. I apologise if some of this is obvious, but fainting is not pleasant and one risks injuring oneself in falling on the hard floor in church.

Please have some breakfast and drink plenty before church.

Take care not to stand up too quickly.

If standing for a while try not to stand totally still, but move your legs and feet. (This helps keep your blood pressure up)

If you feel lightheaded, sick or unwell, sit down, or don't stand up in the first place.

Once sitting down, putting your head between your knees can help you feel better.

Do let the person sitting next to you know you feel unwell so they can get you a glass of water, or help you lie down to recover, or get help from others at church. We are very lucky to have a number of nurses and first aid trained individuals in the congregation.

Please try not to feel silly if you feel ill. It can happen to anyone and we all need help sometimes.
